

A DEPUTATION GOES TO OTTAWA.

His Worship explained to the council at the special meeting on Monday evening that they were called together to consider some important matters respecting the harbor. He explained the position of affairs and concluded by reading a letter from Mr. D'Alton McCarthy who recommended that a deputation be sent to Ottawa on Tuesday. If the council did so, Mr. McCarthy said he would arrange for an interview with the Government on Wednesday.

Messrs. Gullfoyle and Henderson moved that the deputation be composed of Mayor Chamberlain, Reeve Churchill, Messrs. T. Long, E. Stewart R. Emerson, J. Birnie, jr., J. Gullfoyle, H. Y. Telfer, O. Stephens, D. Wilson, and W. T. Toner.

The motion was carried unanimously. A motion placing funds at the disposal of the deputation was also passed and the council adjourned, the business being completed in less than half an hour.
