Steamer Telegram Sold.

This week Capt. H. Cleland dis-
posed of the steamer Telegram to
the Dominion Fish Co., who take
possession at once.

It is understood that the new
owners intend to place the steamer
on the route between Owen Sound,
Wlarton, Lion's Head, Tobermoray,
Providence Bay and The Ducks,
making bi-weekly trips. This route
has been covered for several years
by the steamer Jones, of the Craw-
ford Tug Co., of Wlarton.

The steamer Telegram is 108 feet
in length and 21 feet beam, 9 feet
deep. The gross tonnage is 198
tons, net 134 tons.

Capt. Cleland has not yet decided
what he will do to replace the
Telegram, but he may purchase a
larger steamer to take her place
on the route between Collingwood
and the ports on the east and north
shores.
