

MORE MONEY FOR HARBOR.

The supplementary estimates for the nine months ending March 31, 1907, were laid before Parliament on Wednesday evening. Again the good work of Mr. Leighton McCarthy, M.P., in the interests of our harbor is manifest. Although two or three instalments of estimates have already been brought down this session, Collingwood appearing in all our harbor is again included in the list of those for which appropriations are made. This time the grant is \$20,000, making a total vote of upwards of \$100,000 for the year and nine months, July 1st, 1905, to March 31st, 1907.

Other Ontario harbors on the upper lakes named for appropriations in the supplementaries of Wednesday last are:—

Colchester—Completion of wharf improvements, \$2,000.

Echo Bay Wharf—To complete, \$800.

Magnetawan — Wharf on River Magnetawan, \$1,000.

Mallorytown landing piers — Repairs and additions to, \$1,000.

Addition to Monetteville wharf, on Lake Nipissing, \$900.

Removal of boulders from Magnet Channel, north shore Lake Superior, \$1,000.

North Bay Wharf — Replanking, \$1,200.

Penetanguishene — Wharf improvements, \$1,000.

Point Edward — Dredging, \$5,250.

Sault Ste. Marie Wharf—Dredging approaches, \$50,000.

Sault Ste. Marie Wharf—Improve.
