
NAVIGATION NOTES.

Fears were entertained for the tow barge Sherman, which was caught in the blow on Saturday while crossing Lake Ontario. The barge broke away from the steamer Phoenix and after drifting around for a time was picked up by a tug and towed into Cape Vincent.

The freighter Derbyshire grounded while opposite Morrisburg on Monday. The steamer's cargo was pulpwood.

The steamer Seguin broke a blade while in the Welland Canal on Monday and was detained for a short time while a new blade was put on by a diver.

Two young men have found a piece of wreckage, five feet by sixteen inches, east of the old site of the life-saving station at Port Rowan, with the name of the ill-fated Marquette, which sank last fall. One of its lifeboats and all sorts of wreckage have come ashore near the same place.
