

CONTRACT For STEEL TUG SCHOOL

This week the Collingwood Shipbuilding Company added another contract to their already goodly list. It is for a steel tug for Eddy Bros., the large lumber operators which have their Canadian headquarters at Blind River.

The tug will be constructed of steel throughout. It will be 75 feet over all, 14 feet in width and 9 feet in depth. The motive power will be fore and aft compound engines supplied with steam by a Scotch boiler. Delivery is contracted for in four months. The engines and boilers will be built in the shops here and with them the company will have orders for sixteen or seventeen marine engines in hand.
