

## NEW STEAMER TO BE NAMED DALHOUSIE

The new steamer now under construction in the yards of the Collingwood Shipbuilding Co. to the order of the Canadian Northern interests and which will ply between Toronto and Port Dalhousie, will be named "Dalhousie."

This name was suggested by Mr. J. Halcombrack of St. Catharines, who will receive the prize, a twenty dollar gold piece, for his suggestion. The name was chosen from the several thousand submitted in response to the company's request for suggestions.

The steamer is being constructed on the east side of dry dock No. 1 and is so well advanced that it is anticipated that it will go into commission about June 15th. The steamer will ply in conjunction with the Garden City.
