Equipped with Elesco Superheaters

She was built in 1903, is equipped with twin-screw reciprocating triple expansion engines, and has four single ended Scotch boilers, operated under natural draft.

High degree Elesco Fire Tube Superheaters were installed in the boilers in 1923, capable of giving 200° superheat to the steam at 175 lb. boiler pressure. This boat operates for the greater part of the year on three boilers at an average speed of 12 miles per hour. After the superheaters were installed, tests were made under conditions similar to those under which the boat operated when using saturated steam showing a fuel saving of 13.8%.
